These kinds of videos generate lots of back links really quickly, they win Youtube awards and shoot to the top of Youtube naturally.

The problem is, not all of us are good at making videos like that. Not everyone has any extreme talent and not everyone is able to come up with a video that's so interesting that it goes viral. So what are the rest of us to do? I haven't really seen any services out there lately that create videos that are guaranteed to go viral for you. You cannot predict what people are going to enjoy. It's comparable to a fad, and that sort of thing is generally outside of your control.

So what is someone to do? What if they just have a boring video that they'd like to use to promote a product and you want to do really well with it. Are you left out in the cold? Is it true that now you can't compete on YouTube because you're not a guy who knows a jump through rings of fire or something like that?

So the answer is: it's really not necessary. With the techniques you're about to learn, you can get even your most boring video getting tons of traffic from YouTube.

Because we're sort of going to be gaming the system. By understanding how YouTube's search engine works we will be able to get our video in front of thousands of people regardless of how good it actually is. Of course we always want to make our videos as good as they possibly can be. But this will give you the boost you need until that time, so you can hit the ground running getting lots of traffic loss of sales from your YouTube videos.

Okay now we're going to get into some of the tricks and strategies to getting massive traffic from YouTube videos. Even boring videos, that is.

Many of you might not have a product, and I think you're going to like what I have for you because it's going to give you a chance to start making money right away with these techniques.

So when it comes to getting traffic from YouTube, we must understand that YouTube works on a search engine basis much like Google does. Therefor it has a certain formula that it uses to decide what it considers a good video much in the same way that Google has its own criteria and metrics for deciding what it considers a high quality website.

Obviously these are two very different mediums of providing content there still some basic rules that apply to both mediums. And if we approach this process methodically the same way that we would approach doing search engine optimization on a website for Google, we can achieve great success no matter what is actually going on in our video.

I'm not to get so much into the theory of why these things work. Rather I'm only going to talk about the

action steps strategies that you can use practically with your YouTube video when you upload it that will give you all that will get you fantastic YouTube rankings and tons of YouTube traffic at lighting speed.

Finding The Niche

So I said it needs to be a bit of a methodical process. The first thing that you want to do is figure out what niche you are going to be in. Now many of you might already know what niche you're in because that is the most basic steps you need to take in internet marketing or in any marketing for that matter.

We always need to be sure that we are hitting a target audience with our content. Because those are the people that are going to be most likely to want to buy our products. If we are targeting people that are interested in acne, they might also be interested in a weight loss product. But the chances of making a sale from those people is far lower than it would be if we only charge people who are most interested in what we were doing. So the first thing you need to do is choose your market.

Finding Our "Target" Videos

The next thing we need to do is brainstorm keywords that would be popular on YouTube the same way you might brainstorm keywords on Google. So to do that, first try pull out of your brain what you think will be all the most popular words people search for in your particular market.

For instance if your niche is about making money online, write down words like making money online or make money online but also write down other words and phrases that are talked about frequently in your your niche. For example, you can rest assured that people who are interested in making money online are also interested in various people like Dan Kennedy, Frank Kern, Eben Pagan and other well known names in the industry. You also want to type their names in and do searches on all those people and all the different topics in your niche that people are really interested in.

If acne is your market, don't just type in acne. Also type in "black heads" and other things people are frequently searching for in your niche.




You can use Google's external keyword word tool to help you with this process. Type in your primary keyword to its search box- that will give you some ideas of some secondary keywords that you can use.


Once you've got a nice list of at least 10 very popular keywords, then you can type in your related keywords into the search box when you go back to YouTube.


So what you want to do is very simple. You want to find the video that is both completely related to your niche and also extremely popular. But not just any popular video, but a certain kind of popular video. So we're first going to go to the tab on YouTube that says "Videos". Click on that tab. Then we want to sort the videos by and by the most popular so do an advanced search on that keyword searching only for the videos that have been uploaded **this week** or **today**.


Here are some screenshots so you can see exactly what I mean.











Now the first thing I want to point out to you that most people don't know is that most views on a YouTube video come NOT from people actually searching by keywords. It's different from Google in this way. On YouTube, most videos that are watched are watched because the user was watching a related video and this video came up as a video response (or a related video, more on that later).

We can use that little nugget of information to our advantage.

It means that the responses are critical when it comes to marketing through YouTube and so are the related videos.

You'll see the related videos on the bottom right-hand side of your screen and you'll see the video responses right underneath the video you're watching.


This is the way they have found that people watch videos on YouTube. They don't go using the search box, watch one video and go back to the search box and search for another video. Rather, they search the search box for one video and watch 10 more videos based on what pops up as the video response and what pops up as a related video. So we know that in every niche there are going to be those viral videos videos with anywhere from 10,000 200,000 to even 1 million views. And what we want to do is we want to capitalize on their success and steal away (legally of course) the traffic from their videos.

We want to piggyback off of what they're doing. And one excellent way to do that is to have your videos show up as a video response to that video.

So here is the basic method"

When you find your super popular videos **this week** and **today** that pop up for your niche for your keywords you can pick the most popular ones (just look who has the most views). Then simply upload your video as a video response when you upload it. And now the more traffic viral video gets the more traffic you are going to get. Your video will be going "viral" just because it happens to be connected to a "real" viral video.

You can do this by going to the popular video and just hitting the button that says "Upload a video response".




But there is a reason that I said you should only do this for videos that are most popular **this week** or **today** to do this technique. Because you might think "let me just go after the most popular video of all time and upload my video is a video response." Well that's a good idea but chances are there are going to be 50 to 100 videos that have already been uploaded as a video response to that video. That means your video is going to get lost and it probably won't even show up on the bottom of that video while people are watching it. So the chance of anyone going to see your video that way are very slim.


But if it's a video that on its way up i.e. a newer video that is the most popular one today, it probably doesn't have very many if any video responses at all. So when you upload your video as video response it will show up under their video and you will start getting traffic right away because it will show up immediately when people watch that video .

Here's a killer way I recently found to find out which videos are going to be popular in your category.


Click on Video again like we did last time.



Click on the category that applies to your video.



Then click on "More"/"Rising Videos"



And then you will immediately be shown exactly which videos are one their way up...not all of these will be in your particular niche. But sometimes it's worth it to get lower conversions rates and a lot more traffic if you make more sales at the end of the day. So test things out and see how it goes.

Dominating The "Related Videos"


But there is more.

We know that we are going to use this piggybacking method of leeching off of the traffic of already popular videos.

We have one video that we found that was super popular and we will upload our video as a video response to that one. That's stage I. But then stage II is to find another video that is also popular in our niche and then we want to show up at the most **related** video to that video.

The related videos seem to get even more traffic than the video responses.

This is what I mean when I say showing up as the most related video...



Related videos are extremely important because they not only show up on the bottom right side of the video but they also show up at the end of that person's video ended very screen in which the user is watching it.

So that when a popular video is played and ends....and the user is wondering "what should I do next... I don't want to go back to work... I want to watch another video" your video will be right there waiting for them to click.

It will be the very first thing they see.

Now I'm going to tell you how to do that and it's pretty simple. What you're going to do is tell Youtube that your video is extremely similar to the video they just watched. Now YouTube doesn't know exactly what is on your video. Their search engines are not smart enough (yet) to know what you actually say in your video.

So your video doesn't actually have to be directly related you'll have to actually be talking about that video that they just watched. Yet you can still send a message to YouTube to your video is almost the

same or very similar, so that someone who enjoyed the first video (the viral video) would also enjoy watching yours.

And it's a very simple process. What you do is take the main words in the title of their video and incorporate them into your title. So if it's a video called "guitar hero really sucks" you want to use the word sucks and you want to use the word "Guitar" in your title. You can be a little bit more creative beyond that point, but be sure to use the main buzzwords that show up in his or her title in your title.

That's the first thing you want to do. Then you want to take this a step further.

You are going to see meta tags for the video you are targeting above the description box on their page.

Well if you copy paste their meta-tags and make them exactly...this will do a tremendous amount to make sure that your video should appear to Youtube as the most related video to already popular one.

Believe it or not those two things are usually enough to get your videos showing up as the most similar and related video to that viral video that you are trying to piggyback off and it usually happens pretty fast.

You can see that in the testimonials on the sales letter to this product someone reported that they achieved the number two spot in only two hours using these methods.

So now you are targeting one viral video and we are now number one video response to and then you targeted another viral video that we are now the most related video to.

And if you want to be really sneaky you can create more videos or even the same video under a different account and do it again. Go after another super popular video in your niche and another one and another one etc. The sky is really the limit with this.. to finding popular videos and targeting them in this manner. You can target all the most popular videos on YouTube and completely dominate.


That is one more thing you need to do and that relates to the description box with the video to your targeting.

What you want to do is not copy, but model after..or at least use the keywords of the viral video that you are targeting in your own description box. So you want to take a look at what they say in their description box and make yours similar. Because that is another thing YouTube looks at when deciding if your video is related to theirs.

More On the Description Box

Now let's talk for a moment about the description box. The device allows you to have a heck of a lot more space than most people ever take advantage of. And that description box is one of the most mortant factor to how you're actually going to rank in search engines.

NOTE: Right now I'm NOT about talking about when you're going to show the related video to another video. I'm talking about someone finding your video directly using the search function on YouTube. So they type in "weight loss solutions" or what ever into YouTube and I'm talking about your video popping up first just as you would on a Google search now for the rankings.



In that situation that description box becomes very important.

So here's what I recommend: take your video or another video you create (if it's the same video in your uploading it a second time be sure to use a separate account) and now instead of trying to piggyback off of someone else's traffic try to get the number one ranking yourself.

So how do we go about doing that?

Again their are a number of metrics that YouTube looks and if you want to show up number one you wanted a lot of the things that you do in a Google search engine optimization campaign. And we all know that one of the most important things in good SEO is the name of your website, the domain name and the title tag.

On YouTube it's really no different – the most important thing to the search engine will be the title of your video. So it's a no-brainer to make sure that your keyword is found in the title of your video.

You also want to make sure that your keyword is found in your meta-tags and not only that keyword but related keywords as well. So that's also easy. Simply place your keyword in your title and your meta-tags.

More Comments=Better Rankings

But that's not all that YouTube looks for when it does its ranking. Youtube also tries to figure out how entertaining the video is. And one way it does that is by looking at how many comments are found on that video. So you want to do everything you can to generate as many comments as possible on your video. So while other people would recommend making your video really controversial or interesting to get a lot of comments (which of course would work), we don't always have in our back pocket an extremely controversial or interesting video.

We may just want to sell some affiliate products and some CPA offers with an informational video. So here is a way to generate a lot of comments really fast without having a really incredible video.

When you are making your video, you basically ask the people who are watching it to make comments.

Now it's not just that simple. If you just ask, they would have no reason to comply.

So the way you do this is you make your video in the form of a question. So if you're talking about making money online or talking about losing weight and you're teaching some techniques to share or a review of the product you can ask the viewer and say "whoever is watching right now tell me what is your biggest obstacle when it comes to losing weight? What is the thing hold you back the most?", for instance. Come up with a really intriguing question that you think will generate a lot of response.

You''ll also be amazed at how much people love to have their opinions be heard. So you can also ask opinionated question like "do you agree or disagree with this method of losing weight" or "do you agree or disagree with this semi-ethical tactic of making money." These kind of questions always generate a lot comments and a lot of interest.

If you really want to take this to the next level you can offer some kind of bonus prize for the person who gets the question right or gives the best response. You can offer them a free e-book (be sure they know the real value of that ebook), a free report or maybe even a cash prize to someone that had the

best answer. I am not aware of anything in YouTube's Terms of Service that says that you can offer some kind of prize the person with the best response to a question in your video. ©

After a few months of running it you could just send a personal message through YouTube where you send them a link to your e-book or ask for their PayPal address and send the payment through PayPal. Even 10 or 15 bucks can go a long way here because these people will be having the opportunity to make money just by watching YouTube video. This is something that has probably never happened to them before.

Now if you want to make it a bigger cash prize the rule is "the bigger the prize the bigger the buzz", but of course that won't be necessary when you're just starting out.

Just a medium cash prize or an e-book that clearly has cash value will do the trick and your many comments will quickly generate you some fantastic results in the Youtube search engines.

You may even show up as the video that is most commented on for the day which will give you a whole new boost in the traffic to your video.

YouTube doesn't just look at how many comments there are YouTube also look at how many video responses there are. Now just to recap.

Remember there are three different ways we are trying to get traffic from YouTube. For one thing we are trying to become the number one video response to an extremely popular video.

We also want to be the number one most **related** video to a popular video and thirdly is what we're talking about now: trying to show up number one when people search for a particularly popular keyword.

(Remember that all three of these tactics can be done simultaneously but each one should be done with another one of your videos or the same video from three different accounts).

Now back to getting the top search engine rankings.

The same way we said to offer a cash prize for the best answer or the right answer to a trivia question (you could also ask them some trivia question that relates to your niche), don't forget to suggest that they answer the question via video response. You could even tell them that a video response has a better chance of winning the contest

We are doing this because you want to make sure that we get as many video responses as possible. This is because the quantity of video responses is another major factor that YouTube considers when ranking your video.

Click Through Rates – Get The Click Or Die

Now there is another aspect of this. We all know that an excellent ranking in Google is worthless if you don't have a decent click through rate. The same thing applies on YouTube. You could show up as the number one most related video and not see any major traffic to your if your title doesn't generate enough interest to get people to click on it.

So your title needs to not only be keyword optimized, it needs to be interesting and controversial even if your video isn't.

At least your title should be. So put a little and effort into that. Swimming against the tide will ALWAYS generate clicks. That's pretty easy. For instance, if they're talking about certain system e.g. they're talking about Weight Watchers or something like, consider a title like "why I really hate weight watchers", "why Weight Watchers is a scam".

Then you could mention in your video that "although scam is a really harsh word to use I really don't think of the techniques they teach work nearly as well as this program that I am about to tell you about...so buying product X would be a waste of your money i.e. a scam." and then you simply direct them to the link that you want to promote.

Get The Click To From Your Video To YOUR SITE

Now something that some people don't know when the uploaded video to YouTube is to make sure that the link in your description box be a "live link". That is to say that it should be "clickable" and blue (not a fancy internet marketing term...I'm just talking about the color blue).

We know that click through is on a "live link" will always beat out click through is on a dead link that people need to copy and paste into their browser to get to the website. That's why it's sad that the vast majority of links I see on Youtube are dead as can be.

People simply are not going to want to go through the process.

There's a simple solution and that is just to make sure that you have the following format for your links:

http://www.yourwebsite.com. If you just use the www.mywebsite.com format it will not show up as a live link

Now there's more to getting a click-through than having a live link.

You had also better give the user a darn good reason why they should leave the addictive YouTube for your website. There must be the promise of something really cool that this niche really needs .

There has to be a promise of a free guide or the answer to a specific problem that they are facing.

(Hot tip: Be sure to do a quick search on YouTube on "how to put watermarks into your YouTube video to send click through rates through the roof.)

Now here is another down and dirty trick that you can do to increase your click through rates. As we well know, other peoples' related videos will pop up on the screen after your videos.

Now we don't want people to bounce and go to another video once YOUR video is finished. We want them to go to OUR website. So there is a simple solution that you can do to help ensure that that happens.

What you do is when you are creating your video at the end of your video you want to have the URL where you want to folks to go, whether that be an affiliate link redirect or whatever. I want that URL to actually be the only thing in your video in the middle of screen towards the end of your video. I want to URL to hang on the screen for 5 to 10 seconds maybe even more.

For maximum effect have a reminder of what they'll gain by going there underneath the URL.

Let it hang for a long time. What will happen is that: the person who is watching that video is going to want to do something else, but all he is really staring at is your URL and the call to action. So chances are far greater that he will not wait for this video end because it's completely boring. He'd like to check out the related videos but they aren't showing up (at least not the "on screen" related video suggestions").

So he has little choice but to go ahead and go to your URL. Not everyone will do this but far more people will do it if you pull this little 'shenanigan' that I just told you about.

Back To The Description Box

Now let's go back to the description box for a minute as I said they give of a lot more room there than people realize - and it's really valuable real estate.

Why? Because in addition to having that keyword in your title tags and in your meta-tags, you'll receive great benefit when you have those keywords show up as many times as you possibly can in that description box. It does not appear that YouTube is penalizing you at all for keyword stuffing. Here they are actually rewarding you for keyword stuffing! So what you want to do is have really high density keyword rich articles posted into that description box.

Now I don't want you to go too far overboard with this technique. YouTube could change the rules on us at any time and start penalizing keyword stuffing. So you always want to be doing things that look sort of natural to avoid a slap (they are owned by Google, remember).

But I still recommend putting a full article from very high keyword density (I'm talking about 5% to 10%). If you like, go crazy and jack it up to 20% and if your video get's slapped, simply upload it again from a new account. It's not the end of the world.

So you can do for this article yourself or have a ghostwriter (check Elance.com or WarriorForum.com for great deals) do it for you with that sort of keyword density and put the entire article into the description box. I haven't seen a limit yet how big this description box can get and therefore how many times you can mention your keyword.

I'm sure there is a limit but you can certainly put a full 500 word article into that box with that keyword sprinkled all over the place and you will see a tremendous boost in your rankings for that keyword term right off the bat.

A Note About Video Responses

Now I just want to make one more note about video responses. Video responses are extremely powerful, I believe even more powerful than the comments.

So you want to make sure you have a lot of these to boost your search engine rankings and one thing you could do that is just slightly grey hat is the following: just create more videos of your own and upload them as a video response to your own video.

I have seen people do just this one thing and see really dramatic increases in their rankings in the YouTube search engines. What they did was they started taking video from all over the place (and I don't recommend that you do this it was a copyright violation without a doubt) and upload them to their own video from different accounts as a video response.

You could do the same thing legally by simply making your own videos. They don't need to be poetry or anything like that. Just a simple video mentioning your product will suffice. And when you have a serious amount of video response you're going to get a nice boost in your search engine rankings.

When we take all these techniques together: a strong call to action, a live link keywords in your title tags, keywords in your meta-tags a controversial title as well as becoming a video response and the most related video to others in your niche. When all these technique combine is when you see the true power of these methods. All this together is a recipe for some breathtaking traffic coming to your site.

And since this product is called total YouTube Domination will to say one more thing: and that is that when something works: rinse and repeat ad and never stop..

Go ahead and make another video, target yet another one of the most popular videos on YouTube. Every week they're going to be more and more videos for you to target. So keep doing it.

If you really want to dominate the entire market on YouTube with your video just keep rinsing and repeating this simple process throughout your niche. Keep piggy backing off of the success of others and making sure you are always the number one result for the most popular keywords in your niche.

We are talking about an extremely small amount of time invested for some incredible traffic.

Now remember when it comes to becoming a video response should only go after videos that are the most popular for that day or that week. But when it comes to being the most related video you could go after the most popular videos of all time. And just like in SEO, the stronger the competition is the more difficult it will be. People will have a head start on you people might already have tons of comments, tons of video responses. But do a little bit of research into how strong the competition really is and it will pay off big time.

Since you now know what are the metrics that YouTube really cares about to give you good rankings, you can skillfully analyze your competition.

Look and see: is their meta- really related to the most popular video? Is the most related video's title truly related to the target video's title? Does the video you want to replace have lots and lots of comments today have a lot of video responses? If they don't, you can beat them with all the methods that you have just learned.

With all the tactics I have just told you can take their place is being most related video to the target video.

So you probably have here up to 15 tactics I have taught you that you could use any combination of three or even four of these is going to give you a tremendous boost in traffic from YouTube.

And it really is to your benefit to put these into practice and maximize on them. Because while Google has become a an incredibly competitive place...people need to be building all sorts of back links to get good rankings on Google. That is not the situation at Youtube. Getting great rankings at Youtube is pretty darn easy to do.

That's because people just don't know the stuff you have just learned. So you are going to just walk into the niche of your choice and just lay waste to the competition.

It's like taking candy from a baby or like an adult playing basketball with a bunch of little kids. It's going to be really no competition at all if you use several of these techniques together.

Here is one more really crazy technique and I've got to give credit to Charles Kirkland for this one.

He recommended the following technique: let's say you come across an extremely popular video from (for instance_ a 15-year-old or 12-year-old kid. They have no idea how to monetize video or even that they could monetize that video.

Yet, they are getting tons of traffic.

Now those tremendous number of views might not be all that important to them. But to you it is important. Because you know that a lot of traffic and that niche can bring you a nice chunk of money every single week.

So you can make an offer to the owner of the account and say "hey I want to buy that account off you". I have seen this been done successfully for little as \$20. The kid is really happy because all of the sudden they are making money from their YouTube video and they didn't even know that they could do that. They're going to go out and buy some new sneakers or whatever. Meanwhile you are stealing away all this viral traffic from some topic as random as how to make a a BB gun.

And then you're going to go on Google and type" BB gun affiliate" and you're going to look at commission Junction and on Amazon.com and ebay's affiliate program. You're going to look all over the internet for affiliate programs that would be of interest to these people so you can start cashing in on all of this viral traffic.

And nobody even needs to know that you are the new owner of the account.

And as a bonus when you buy the account you'll also likely get a huge list of subscribers. So you basically just bought a new targeted genuine mailing list that you can now market to with various offers It's a pretty sweet deal especially if you can get it for anything less than 100 bucks.

You can learn a lot from one of the most successful examples of monetization of of a YouTube video.

And that would be a guy who by the name "Funtwo". He plays a song on guitar called Canon Rock and it has 51 million views on YouTube last time I checked. Everyone simply loves his version of the song and nobody even realizes that the guy playing guitar in the video is not the owner of this YouTube account.

And he is not the guy who uploaded this video. Yet the guy who uploaded the video is writing in the description box in the first person as if he is the player even though he is not and here's what he says "I learned how to play guitar with GuitarMasterPro.net practice practice practice and get a good copy of guitar Master Pro that's how I did it. Good luck!"

That is a pretty simple description. No entire article, he just did a quick tagline and a call to action. But it did the trick. This guitar Master Pro is just another guitar website... but it is now the top 3,000 websites in the world because he piggy-backing off of the viral traffic this video generates.

Now what he did is probably a copyright violation and he could get in trouble if he didn't have permission from the owner of the video to post it. But it's also possible that the owner of the video is getting a cut of the profits. Because with 50 million views you can bet he is making some nice money off of this video.

But what you could do and what he should have done if you see some sort of video going viral and it's not being monetize in any way you could go to them and make some kind of offer using the. Tell them they can keep their video if you're short on cash. Just pay a very small amount to have the right to repost it under your own account. Tell them you're going to upload their video and give them a cut of the profit from all the sales that will be produced.

Then are going to use all of these techniques you just learned to get the traffic flowing to the video, and before know it it will have far more views than the original video.

If he didn't know better you could just offer to buy his entire account. Now that might not work for an account that is established like funtow who already has 50 million views. You probably need to pay quite a pretty penny to own that account. But you might just come across a video that you know will be really popular because it it's so fantastic but it's only been recently uploaded that might be a good time to drop in and make an offer to that person to buy the account for \$100 and start cashing in all the traffic that that video provides.

Now on to the section I told you about at the beginning of the PDF. Let's talk about a really easy way to start making money with your own videos.

What I recommend that you do is you go over to siteflippinggold.com

This product was a warrior special offer and it sold extremely well and now it's gone on to the rest of the Internet at \$27 a pop. You will get 100% commissions on that product if you join my affiliate program.

But I'm not just going to give you 100% commissions. I am going to give you 130% on this product . I can do that because there is a backend product called Total Niche Domination which is another incredibly powerful product that sells for \$77 and I am giving a 30% commission on that so you are getting your getting well over 50 bucks per sale when someone gets both products (which happens at an extremely high rate).
